Recorder Karate Gold Belt

To earn your gold belt in recorder karate, you must write and perform an original 8 measure long piece of music written for recorder! In your composition, you must include the following:

- At LEAST four different pitches (D, E, F#, G, A, B, C, D')
- At LEAST two different types of note/rest values (whole, half, quarter, eighth, etc.)
- A treble clef and key signature at the beginning of each line
- A time signature (use 3/4 or 4/4) after the key signature on the first line
- Bar lines between each measure
- A double bar line at the end of the song
- All measures must contain the appropriate amount of beats for the time signature you have chosen

You must turn your written composition in to Ms. Barker before testing for your gold belt.
